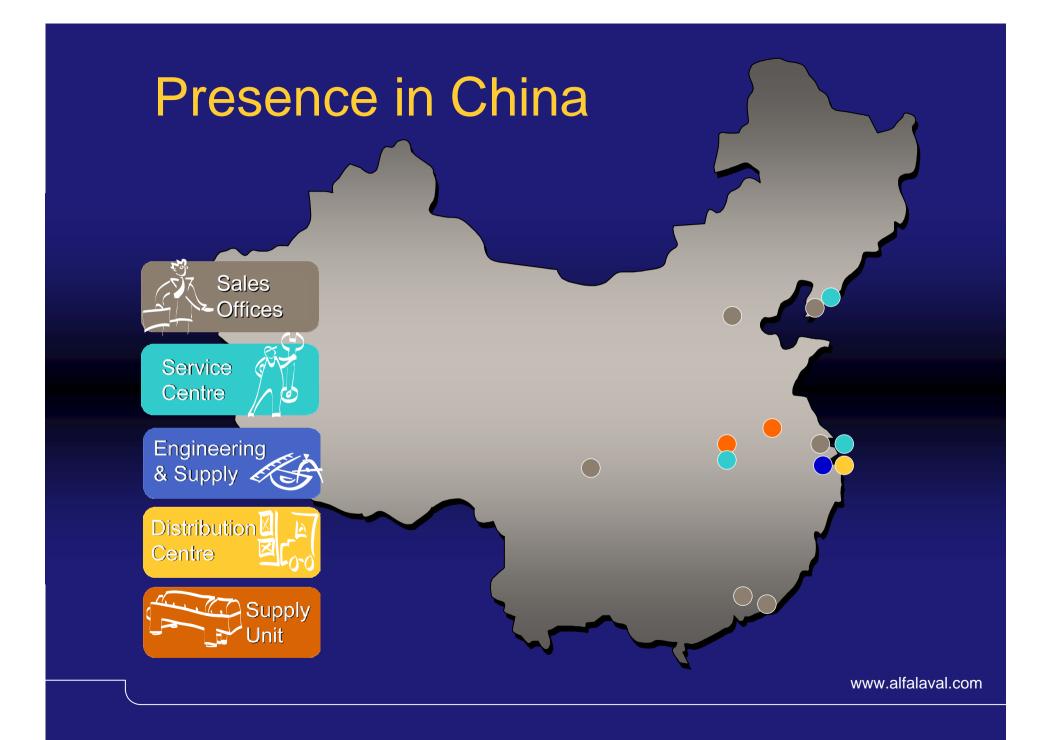

#### **Economic Outlook**

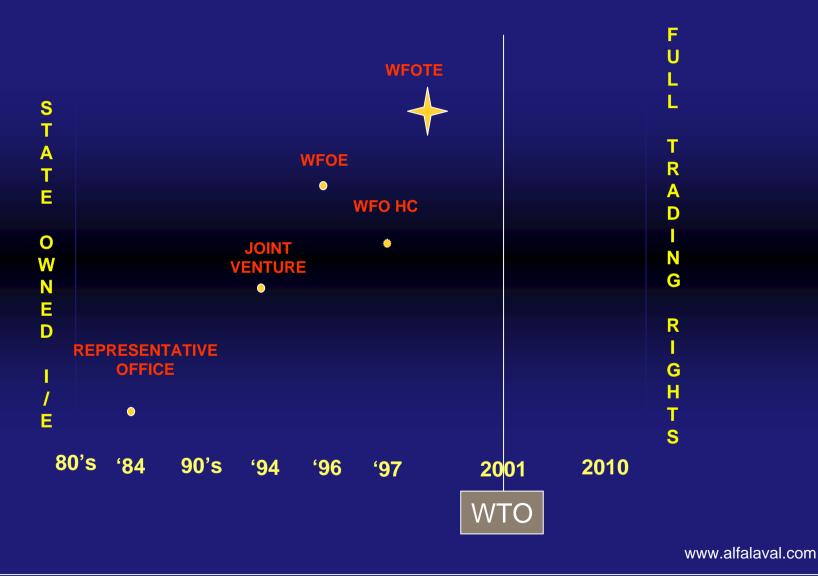
- China continues to be the fastest growing major economy in the world

- Continued record levels of Foreign Direct Investments (US\$ 60bn in 2004) and growing Outward FDI
- Further need to reduce level on non-performing loans in the banking sector
- Continues fears that the current high growth rate is unsustainable
- Continued pressure on revaluation of the Yuan

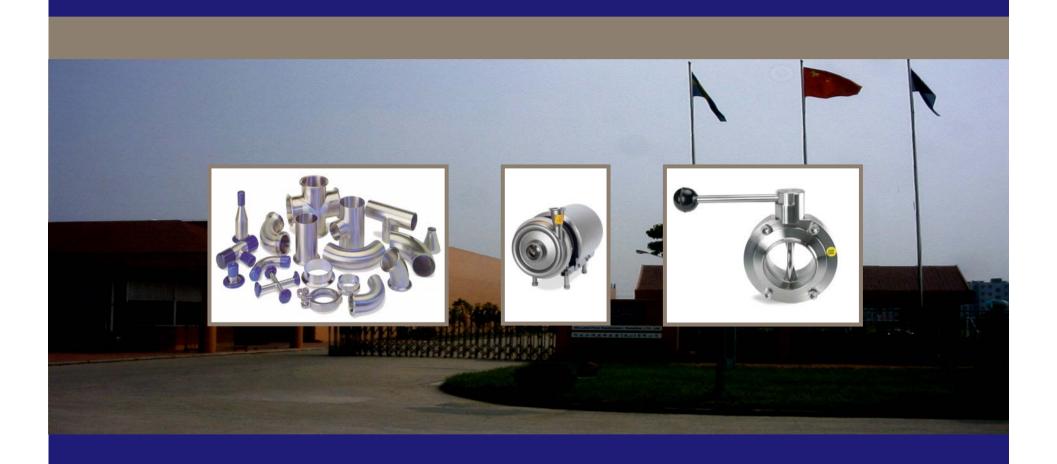

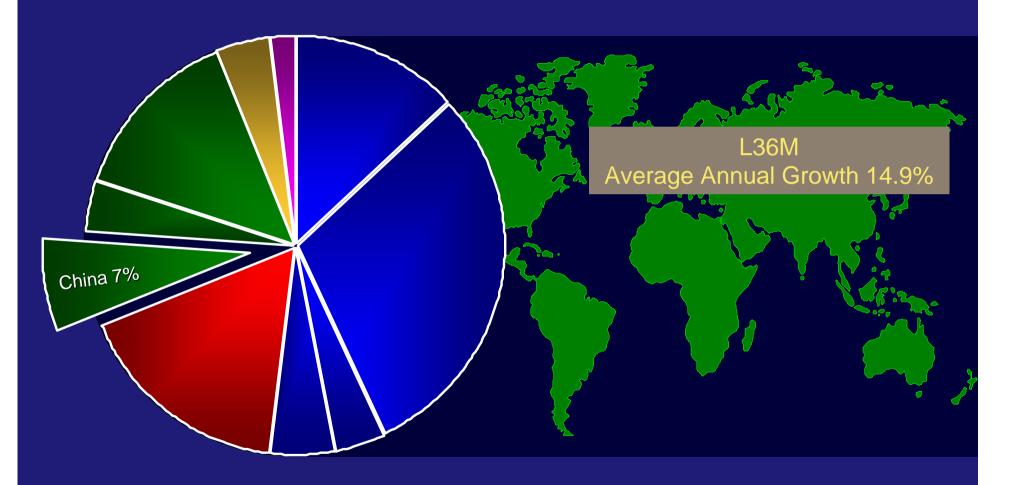

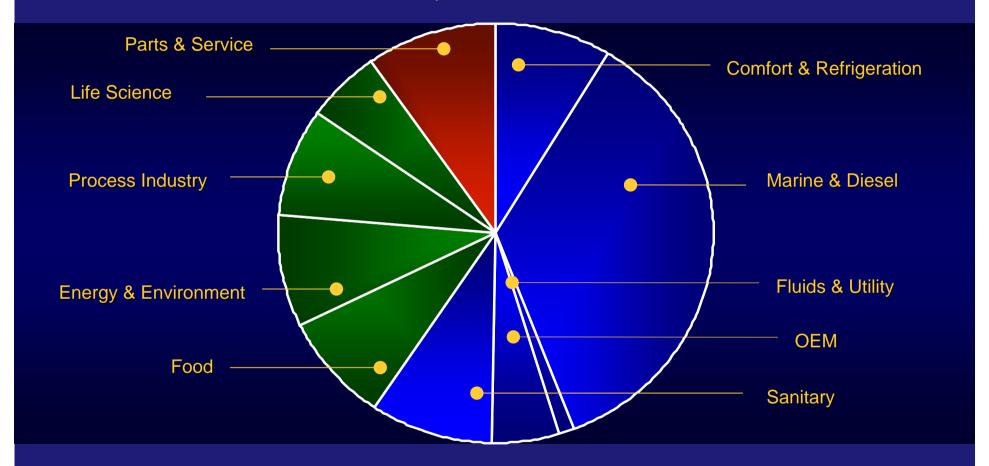


# Orders received by Country



## Orders received by Segment

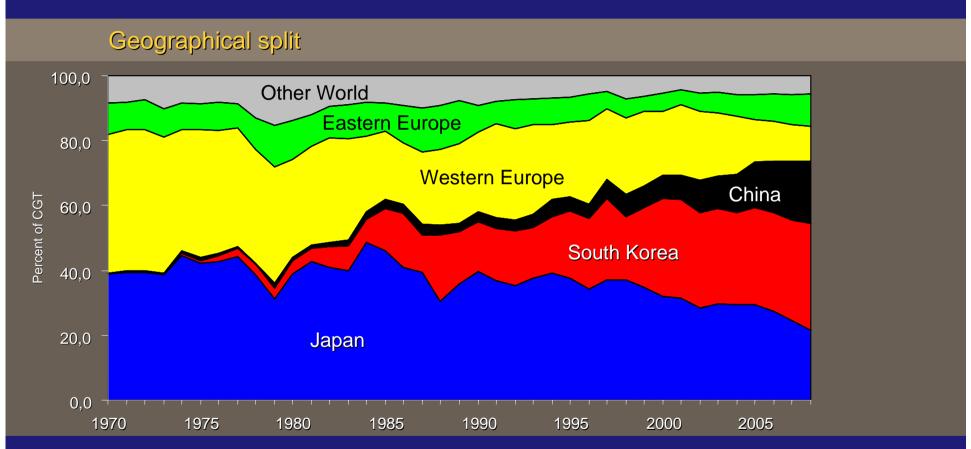

# The markets we are in ... a few highlights

- Nuclear Power China will build 30 more nuclear power units and increase its installed capacity to 40GW by 2020
- Fuel Ethanol production is expected to increase from 0.4 to
  3.5 MTPA over next 10 years
- Refining By 2020 capacity is expected to be up by 85% to 450MTPA which means 10-12 new refineries and petrochemical facilities
- Refrigeration Both industrial and commercial refrigeration markets are expected to continue to grow at rates between 15-20%
- Shipbuilding China is expanding its shipbuilding capacity and is today with 14% the third largest player in the market
