The time to decide has come

- The International Ballast Water Management Convention has been ratified and will enter into force on 8 September, 2017
- All ships calling at US ports that intend to discharge ballast water must treat with an approved system







- Introduction of marine species into foreign environments is one of today's most critical environmental issues
- Regulations that govern ballast water treatment are designed to stop a devastating wave of marine biological invasions

- Type approved by IMO and USCG
